A thought for this week . . .

Essays for a New Era in the Armenian Church by His Holiness, Kareki I

There is no need to quote here any specific definition of the church. We all know that the church is that society of men and women who are called by God through his Son, Jesus Christ, to live according to His will, in unity with Him and with each other, and to fulfill the ultimate purpose of his creation in the establishment of His Kingdom.

Of course there are important nuances in our understanding of the actual manifestation of this unity in God and among men which constitutes the fundamental reality of the church.

Whether we stress the Catholic-Orthodox understanding of the sacramental and institutional character of the church or the Protestant understanding with its emphasis on a charismatic nature, we all agree that the church is not a multitude of individual Christians. The social-communal characters of the church is well expressed in the image of the body, which is used in describing the nation. In the case of the church, we use the expression "Mystical Body of Christ," while in referring to a nation we use the term "social body."

MIDDAY READINGS ASCRIBED FOR THIS SUNDAY:

ACTS 9:23-31:

Saul (St. Paul) is rejected by the Apostles who knew how he once persecuted the followers of Christ. Saul, however, boldly preaches the Good News of the Risen Christ throughout Jerusalem.

I PETER 2:1-10:

A new birth means new life. To love one another as Christians requires the elimination of characteristics of the old life. They must be stripped off with relentless severity. As Jesus is the Messiah, King of the New Kingdom, His subjects are priesthood. The function of the Church (laity) is to declare the wonderful deeds of God's redeeming love by offering ourselves as spiritual sacrifices through Jesus Christ.

JOHN 2:23-3:12

Jesus speaks of the necessity of baptism, which is the mystery of rebirth in faith. When we were baptized as children, the Church proclaimed the fact that God reaches out in love to all men, adopting them as His own. Our parents and sponsors acknowledged this adoption and promised to ensure our growth as God's children.

As adults, we are called upon to affirm in our lives this rebirth. Our lives should be new lives, full of love, joy, understanding and peace, reflecting the reality of our baptism.


