THE PENTECOST

Pentecost is one of the most important feasts on the Christian calendar that falls fifty days after Easter. We frequently identify this celebration, which falls on June 8th this year, as the "Birthday" of the Christian Church.

But why? What makes the Pentecost event such an important milestone for the Christian faith?

The feast marks the event of the descent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles of Jesus gathered in the Upper Room in Jerusalem, 50 days after Resurrection, in anticipation of the fulfillment of the Lord's promise that altered their life.

The Holy Spirit came in the form of a tongues of fire, "as of a rushing wind," rested upon the apostles and transformed them from a group of fearful and timid individuals into a force of bold and empowered leaders.

It was the Holy Spirit who filled the apostles and inspired them to move out into the world and preach the Good News of Christ's Resurrection.

It was the coming of the Spirit of God, Hokekalusd, which gave birth

to the fellowship of the Church. Therefore our Church celebrates Pentecost not just as a historical event but as the feast of empowerment of every believer who receives the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Holy Chrismation. Fulfilled with the Holy Spirit many of the followers of Jesus Christ became great preachers and apologists for the new faith. In similar way we also lead and direct our lives along the way of Jesus. Let us pray for our own personal renewal in the Holy Spirit, and rejoice in our spiritual birthday.

"The Comforter, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and make you remember all that I have told you." (John 14:26).

The descent of the Holy Spirit is described in the Acts of the Apostles: (Acts 2:1-4).

After Easter, and according to the Armenian Christian tradition, Der Hayr will bless our homes. This blessed tradition occurs on the feasts of Christmas and Easter each year. Պենտեկոստեի դեպքին արդիւնքները քլխաւորաբար երկուք են: Առաքեալներու կեանքին մեջ ճիմնական փոփոխութիւններ յառաջ բերուեցան:

Փոխուեցան անոնց զգացումները, խորճուրդները, կեանքի հանդեպ անոնց գաղափաբարները: Փոխուցաննաեւ անոնց շարժումները, որովհետեւ Աստուծոյ Սուրբ Հոգին ցոյց տուաւ իրենց որ աշխարհը ուրիշ կերպարանք մը եւ նոր իմաստ մը ունի եւ իրենք ալ աշխարհի համար նորոգուած անձեր եղան: Առաջ վախկոտ եին, բայց ահա հիմա քաջութեամբ լեցուած են եւ պատրաստ են դարձնելու իրենց կեանքը իբր միջոց նուիրուելու եւ ծառայելու համար: Առաքեալները ընդունելե յետոյ Սուրբ Հոգիի շնորհները անմիջապես դուրս ելան վերնատունեն ու սկսան իրենց քարոցութիւնը կատարել:

Անոնք կը խօսեին հրապարակներու մեջ հաւաքուած զանազան մարդոց հետ տարբեր լեզուներով: Ունկնդրողներեն շատեր որոնք գիտեին Յիսուսի աշակերտներուն ունեցած կարողութիւնները, ափ ի բերան կը մնային` լսելով անոնց ոգեւորիչ ու հռետորական բանախօսութիւնները: Անոնք որպես ականատեսներ կը վկայեին իրենց Վարդապետին կատարած հրաշագործութիւնները` կը մեկնաբանեին Քրիստոսի խօսքերը ու քրիստոնեայ կը դարձնեին շատեր Սուրբ մկրտութեամբ։

Պենտեկոստեի միս գլխաւոր արդիւնքն եր որ երեւան բերաւ՝ Քրիստոնեական Եկեղեցւոյ հրաշալի հաստատութիւնը՝ այսինքն ծնաւ քրիստոնեական Եկեղեցին:

Քրիստոնեաներուն թիւը Սուրբ Հոգիի իջած օրը 120 եր բայց Պետրոս առաքեալի քարոզութեամբ (քարոզողը՝ Սուրբ Հոգին եր) 3000 հոգիներ մեկ անգամեն դարձի եկան եւ իրենց թիւը աճելով դարե ի դար այսօր 800 միլիոնը անցաւ: Հրաշալի ու յարատեւ այս աճումը Եկեղեցին կը պարտի՝ Ս.Հոգիի ներգործութեան, առաքեալներու եւ առաջին քրիստոնեաներու աղօթքին, հաւատքին, գործին եւ նուիրումին:

MIDDAY READINGS ASCRIBED FOR THIS SUNDAY:

ACTS 2:1-21; JOHN 14:25-31:

ACTS 2:1-21:

The coming of the Holy Spirit is the event commemorated on Pentecost. One basic result of the presence of the Holy Spirit is that persons were able to communicate with one another. The Holy Spirit creates community, a gathering together of people who can, in the spirit understand and relate to one another. The tragedy of our time is that there is so much isolation and separation among men that there is very little real communication. Over-specialization, compartmentalization, ego, ethnic, racial, social and political barriers isolate people in our society, as well as within parish communities. Pentecost reminds us that the Church, filled with the Spirit, is called to break down barriers, reconciling mankind to each other and to God. Each one of us is asked to help break those barriers.

JOHN 14:25-31:

The Gospel reading is a lengthy teaching and prayer from Jesus to and for his disciples before his passion and death. In this reading Jesus affirms that he and God are one, and therefore the words that Jesus speaks, and the works that he does, are those that God has chosen for him to speak, and do. Jesus enjoins his followers to keep his commandment of Love, and he tells them that whenever they are about the business of doing this; **the Comforter, Counselor, Helper promised by Jesus the Holy Spirit** of God will be with them to assist them. As Jesus has taught his followers by word and example, so the Holy Spirit will continue to teach and lead all who seek to follow Christ. Jesus knows that the world will change and that the challenges and questions his followers will face will be many. What He promises is that when there is a need for help and guidance, the Holy Spirit will be with us. The deepest danger we face as Christians is a disobedience of spirit that makes us un-teachable. Christ is crucified because men are not open to His indwelling. He gives, but we must receive. He comes, but we must welcome Him to live with us and to teach us.

We honor the person by presenting them with a light candle and saying: "anoonovut dzeranas" "may you grow old with your name" which in turns means wishing the person a long life.
